Floyd Arthur Rose, age 91 of Forest died Tue. July 4, 2017 at Lima Memorial Hospital, Lima. He was born on Dec. 13, 1925 to the late Merritt and Austa (Aam) Rose. He married Bertha Mae Hartle on Aug. 12, 1951, and she preceded him in death on died Dec. 8, 2009.

Mr. Rose is survived by a son Chris (Nancy) Rose, Upper Sandusky, a daughter Kathy (Flip) Smith, AR, a daughter-in-law Darlene Rose, MD, seven grandchildren, six great grandchildren and a sister Patricia (Rex) Redding, Kenton. He was preceded in death by a son Mark Rose, two sisters Marjorie Wolford and Jo Ann Hensel.

He graduated from Marseilles High School with the class of 1943. Mr. Rose was WWII veteran of US Army. He was a lifelong grain and livestock farmer. Mr. Rose was a member of Marseilles Presbyterian Church. Mr. Rose was a Marseilles Twp. Trustee for 15 years. He was a member of Wyandot County Fair Board for 21 years. Mr. Rose was a member of Marseilles Masonic Lodge #515, and Warpole Lodge #176. He held the record in the 440 yard dash in the Wyandot County Track Meet and placed 4th at the state meet. He enjoyed bowling in multiple leagues in Upper Sandusky and Kenton, cutting fire wood, mowing the lawn, woodworking, and he was an avid OSU fan. He was proud of his Norwegian heritage.

Funeral services will be held Sat. July 8, 2017 at 10:30 a.m. in the Bringman Clark Funeral Home with Rev. Mary Curtis and Rev. Rex Roth officiating. Visitation will be held Fri. July 7, 2017 from 4-7 p.m. at the Bringman Clark Funeral Home. A Masonic Memorial Service will be conducted at 7PM the evening of visitation.
