N. Maxine Ulrich age 94 of Upper Sandusky died Sun. February 25, 2018 at Fairhaven Health Care Community. She was born March 13, 1923 in Wyandot County to the late James R. and Blanche E. (Fullmer) Lay. She married Paul R. Ulrich on December 25, 1942 in Upper Sandusky. He died January 7, 1967.

Mrs. Ulrich graduated from Upper Sandusky High School in 1941. She retired in 1988 after 25 years as the supervisor of food service for the Upper Sandusky School System. She is a member of John Stewart United Methodist Church, where she is a member of UMC Women. She was a former member and Sunday school teacher of Trinity United Methodist Church where she was involved in various church committees, including Progressive Class. She was the first woman trustee, where she held several offices. She was also a past delegate of the annual church conference and an officer of the Findlay District Mission Team. Mrs. Ulrich participated in the first ever Greater Findlay Women's Emmaus Walk and was one of the original founders of the Ladies Lenten Luncheons. She enjoyed reading, cooking, and loved her pet dogs, especially Kilt.
