



## Adam N. Hollanshead

May 26, 1978 - February 5, 2025

Adam Neil Hollanshead, son of Lee and Carol(Ulrich) Hollanshead, passed away at his home in Silverton, Oregon on February 5, 2025 after suffering a sudden heart attack. He was born on May 26, 1978. He is survived by his mother and father, sister, Anna Barrett (Cory Griswold) of Upper Sandusky and brother, Alex Hollanshead (Christine) of Charlotte, NC. His German Shepard dog, Ilya, was his constant companion and accompanied him everywhere.
