Albert P. Riggs age 88 of Williamstown, OH died on Thursday February 5, 2009

at St. Rita's Medical Center in Lima, OH. Al was born on September 18, 1920 to his parents Louis and Martha (Shaw) Riggs in Cambridge, OH. He graduated from Cambridge High School in 1939 and served in the United States Army Air Corp during World War II.

In the Army Air Corp, Al was trained and served as an electrician on large bomber and cargo aircraft. After the service, he came to northwest Ohio and began his career as a factory electrician ultimately retiring from the Truck Axle Division of Rockwell International in Kenton, OH.

Albert married Lovalene G. (Elwood) Riggs in 1954 and they have celebrated over 54 years together in the home they built near Williamstown. Albert is survived by his wife Lovalene, their two sons, James (Phyllis) of Pickerington, OH and Scott of Williamstown, their two grandsons Benjamin and Matthew of Pickerington, and many relatives and friends in Hardin, Hancock, and Wyandot counties.
