Alice J. Swartz age 91 of Upper Sandusky, died Apr. 3, 2023 at the Wyandot County Skilled Nursing & Rehabilitation Center. She was born Aug. 28, 1931 in Carey to the late Joseph B. and Eva L. (Day) Gibson. She married Calvin L. Swartz on Aug. 2, 1960 and he preceded her in death on Nov. 10, 1979.

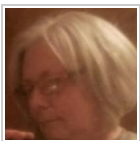
