Almeda Annette (Harrison) Passet, age 90, of TH 87, Wharton, died at 10:45PM on Sat. Mar 5, 2011 at her residence. She was born on April 26, 1920 in Riley County, KS, to the late Roger B. & Hermina (Quantic) Harrison. She married Norman F. Passet at her parents' home on Sep 2, 1944, and the two celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary a few months before his death in 2009. Almeda was a member of the North Salem Lutheran Church.

Almeda is survived by a son and daughter-in-law, Roger & Iris Passet, near Wharton, with whom she made her home for the past five years; a daughter, Joanne, of Richmond, IN, three grandsons, Jason (Julie), Ryan, & Gregory Passet; two step-grandsons, Jeremy (Kim) & Joshua (Amy) Hankins; two great-grandsons, Nikolas & Garret Passet; and five step-great-grandchildren, Addy, Avery & Taylor Hankins and Avery and Christian Davis. She enjoyed flower and vegetable gardening, canning fruits and vegetables, baking, needlework, sewing, reading and spending time with

her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Almeda helped make many quilts for Lutheran World Relief. She also served as a leader of the Wharton Busy Bees 4-H club and was active in the Country Neighbors Hospital Guild. She will be remembered for her sweet smile and thoughtfulness.
