Bernard M. (Pete) Kin, age 89 of Upper Sandusky died at Fairhaven Community on Monday March 26, 2012 at 2:20 p.m. He was born on March 12, 1923 in Salem Twp. to Leo and Mary (Mitten) Kin. He retired from Midwest tool after 20 years.
