“ My brothers and I found out that Betty had passed away and we were reminiscing, and I thought I'd share it. We lived 2 doors down from the Wells's in our childhood home on Summit Street in Upper Sandusky from 1960 to 1968 (we now live in Florida). The Wells's lived adjacent to the East School playground and on the other side of their house was a vacant lot that we played ball games on. Our family had 3 boys and 1 girl, the Nelson's had 2 boys and 1 girl, the Wells's had 4 girls, plus there were many other children in the neighborhood. It was an ideal place to grow up. My brothers and I remembered when the Wells's had a carport that got remodeled and it was turned into a very impressive room with a large fireplace. I think it was the first time I ever knew anybody who had a fireplace, so I thought they were rich. They also took nice vacations, too, as I recollect. The Wells' had a built-in table and booth in their kitchen and I thought that was cool. We also recalled that the Wells's had a white fence around their back yard, and in the summer, they had an above-ground pool there (another reason why I thought they were rich--LOL!). I remember crawling under the fence to get into their back yard! I believe that some dogs did the same thing! We weren't supposed to, of course, but Mrs. Wells did not scold me or anything. She said to just come to the front door to get into the back yard to play. Duh! She always had a big smile on her face and seemed to be delighted around us kids. I also remember the summer when the 3 mothers: Mrs. LaBolt (my mom), Mrs. Nelson, and Mrs. Wells took us neighborhood kids to Camp Young. It was early for all of us, and I remember Mrs. Wells joking about it, and being very good-natured. I ran into Betty when I was a teenager and she was working at the bank and she was as cheery as always. The details of my remembrances may be a little faded, but our condolences to the family is resounding. May she rest in paradise.

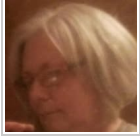
