Carl E. Deckler age 80 of Upper Sandusky died Sun. May 23, 2021 at his residence. He was born June 19, 1940 in Alvada to the late Emil & Gladys (Kinn) Deckler.

He married Sandy L. Reis on Oct. 28, 1961 and she survives in Upper Sandusky. He then was the Director of Transportation for the Riverdale School System, and later became the Director of Transportation for the Upper Sandusky Exempted Village School District. Mr. Deckler was a member of Knights of Columbus Council 2050, and Thorns & Roses Garden Club in Mt. Victory. He was known as Mr. Fix-it, and he helped his wife in her antique shop especially when it came to repairing the antique items. He enjoyed deer hunting, and was a very serious and competitive card player, especially when it came to Euchre and
