Charles Sherman Baldwin Jr., age 63 of Columbus died 6:11AM on Fri. Apr. 25, 2014 at the Kobacker House, Columbus. He was born June 2, 1950 in Columbus to the late Charles and Marian (Turner) Baldwin. For 21 years he was a life flight paramedic for Grant Hospital Life Flight and worked with trauma and heart program at Grant Hospital, an EMS instructor at Eastland Career Center, Anheuser Busch and Hocking Technical School. He served on South-East Ohio EMS for 14 years, and was a lieutenant for Lawrence County Sheriff's Department. He also worked construction. Mr. Baldwin was a former member of the Ohio EMS and notarizer for the state of Ohio. He enjoyed sailing on his sailboat in North Carolina, he loved music, Charles played the guitar and the piano, he enjoy construction and was an instructor of many trades to help others with their needs.
