August 11, 1916 - December 5, 2020

Charles E. Hehr age 104 of Upper Sandusky died Sat. Dec. 5, 2020 at Fairhaven Health Care Community. He was born Aug. 11, 1916 in Peoria, IL to the late Robert J. & Grace E. (Troup) Hehr. He married M. Jane Myers on Jan. 28, 1939 in Greenup, KY and they celebrated 76 years of marriage. Jane passed on Feb. 10, 2015.
