Charles Earl Harbaugh age 89, of Upper Sandusky died on Sunday Sept. 30, 2012 at his residence. He was born on January 1, 1923 in Osterburg, PA to Charles Vertis and Lela (Claycomb) Harbaugh. Mr. Harbaugh married Dorine E. Brant on July 11, 1945 in Johnstown, PA and she survives in Upper Sandusky.

He has a son surviving Rick E. (Lynn) Harbaugh of Tiffin, daughter Patti D. He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers Robert & Jack Harbaugh and an infant sister Amanda.

Mr. Harbaugh was a member of First Lutheran Church, Upper Sandusky. He was an Army Veteran serving in WWII as a Master Sergeant in the Air Corps. Mr. Harbaugh military occupation was a Tail Gunner on a B17. He was shot down and taken prisoner of war. During the Korean Conflict he enlisted the Pennsylvania National Guard and helped recruit trainees. Mr. Harbaugh was a warrant officer W-2. He was a tool and die maker for National Machinery for 29 years and retired in 1986.

Mr. Harbaugh was a former member of Masonic Lodge F & AM 77, Tiffin, and Eastern Star Chapter 189 of Tiffin where he served as Worthy Patron. He was a member of AmVets Post 777 of Upper Sandusky and National Machinery Quarter Century Club, Tiffin. For Hobbies he enjoyed the computer, reading, playing Bridge where he earned the title of Life Master, gardening and working sudoku puzzles. He was a proud man who loved his family.
