Cheryl Lynn Weber 63, of Mt. Blanchard went home to be with the Lord on Sat. June 25, 2016. Cheryl was born Apr. 1, 1953 to the late William N. Dilley and Anna M. (Born) Dilley of Patterson. She married her high school sweetheart Patrick R. Weber on August 4, 1973 and he survives.

In addition to her husband and mother, Cheryl is survived by two sons and their families: Ty (Emily) Weber of Forest and their sons Lex and Tate, and Scott (Heather) Weber of Forest, their daughter Madelynn and sons Eli and Lincoln. 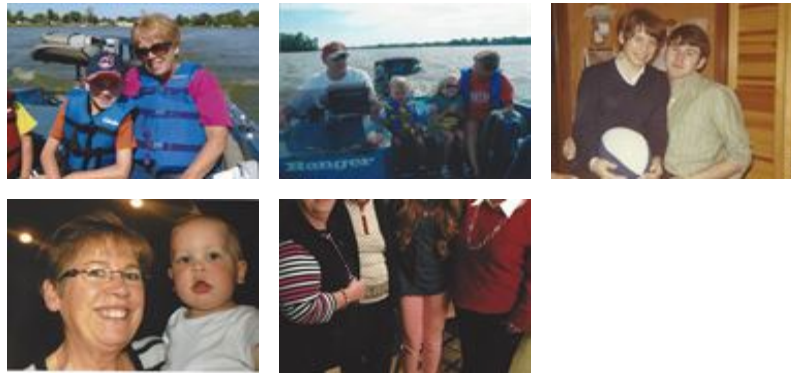
