Funeral services for Clarence E. Barr, 80, of 101 W. Franklin St., Wharton, will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday at Wharton Church of God, the Revs. Craig Haines and Melvin Summy officiating. Burial will be in Wharton-Richland Union Cemetery, with military rites by McVitty Memorial VFW Post 1182 and American Legion Post 259.

Visitation will be held from 2-9 p.m. Tuesday at Shields Funeral Home, Forest.

Mr. Barr died at 11:10 a.m. Saturday, Nov. 17, 2001, at Winebrenner Village, Findlay.

He was born Sept. 8, 1921, in Sandusky County to C. Lester and Dessie (Jones) Barr. He married Marjorie M. Weller on Dec. 4, 1946, and she survives.

Also surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Roger (Becky) Rodabaugh, Pensacola, Fla.; and Mrs. Charles (Debbie) Cottrell, Lafayette, La.; four grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; and a sister, Mrs. James (Shirley) Dunlap, Buffalo, Wyo.

Mr. Barr retired in 1987 as senior design engineer at Marion Power Shovel after 34 years, including two years in Australia.

He was a U.S. Army Air Forces veteran of World War II, serving in the South Pacific. He also was a Korean War veteran.

He was a member of Wharton Church of God and Gideons International.
