Dale Weber Jr. age 94 of Upper Sandusky died Fri. May 19, 2017 at Wyandot Memorial Hospital. He was born Dec. 26, 1922 in Forest to the late Rex Dale & Rebecca (Underwood) Weber. He married Rosella M. Groat on Feb. 20, 1946 and she died Aug. 2, 2013. He was also preceded in death by a daughter Beverly J. Houser, a brother John Weber, a sister Geneva Stewart, and a son-in-law Donald Karg.

Mr. Weber is survived by a son Barry (Diane) Weber, North Canton, a daughter Becky Karg, Upper Sandusky, 9 grandchildren, 18 great grandchildren, 2 great great grandchild, and a sister Mary Bridger, MD.

He was a graduate of Forest High School. Mr. Weber was WWII Veteran of the U.S. Army serving in the Asiatic-Pacific Theater. He was a farmer and worked for the former Lite Star Oil Co. in Upper Sandusky where he ran a gas delivery route for many years. Mr. Weber was a member of VFW Post 2842, BPOE 83, WWII U.S. Army Searchlight Battalion. He enjoyed baseball, especially the Cincinnati Reds, and making wood craft projects with his wife.

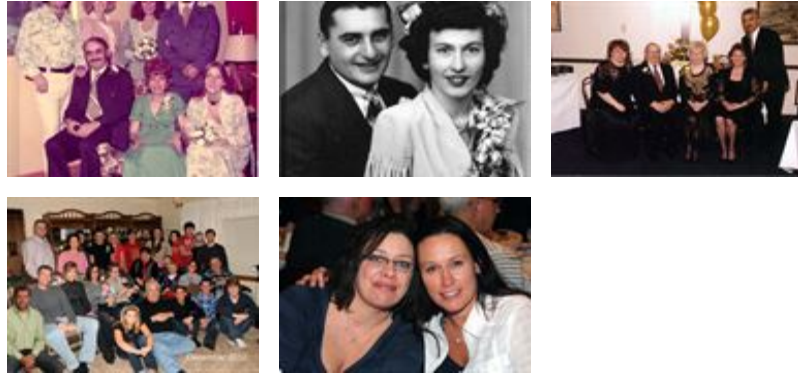
