He served on several dairy and swine livestock boards, former 4-H advisor 12 years, little league coach, member of the hospital Board of Governors, former U.S. Commission Co. Board of Director for 9 years and a member of the Eden Grange for many years. He was office manager of the OBES for 4 yrs .in Upper Sandusky and later in Findlay, OH. He was the Farmers Market Master for Wyandot Co. for 16 yrs., Wyandot Memorial Hosp., volunteer, he was chairman of the Wyandot Co. Board of Elections for the past 10 years, past president of the Democratic Party and served on the social committee. He was 3 times past Exalted Ruler of BPOE 83 1980, 1993, 2003, he also served on the House committee and a member of the PER Association, was a member of the American Legion Post 225, and AmVets 777.

He was a member of the Smithville United Methodist Church and has been attending the Trinity United Church of Christ. He bowled in the King and Queens League for several years and the Monday night Elks League. He was an avid golfer, sports fan, and enjoyed reading, working cross word puzzles, playing cards, singing, fishing, mushroom hunting, entertaining, and breakfast at McDonalds.
