David C. Mason age 84, of Upper Sandusky, died on Saturday February 15, 2020 at Blanchard Valley Hospital in Findlay.

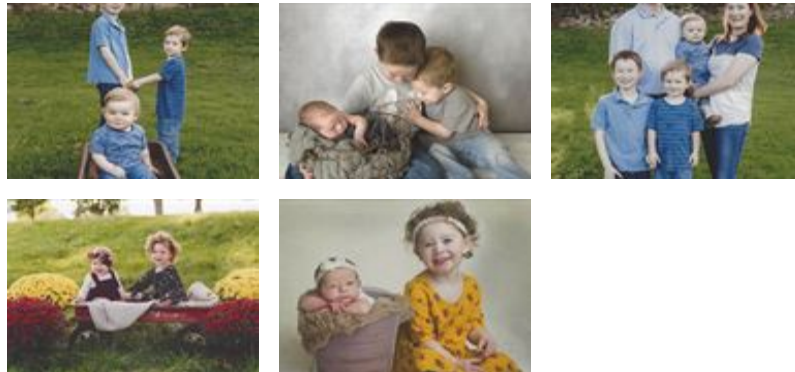

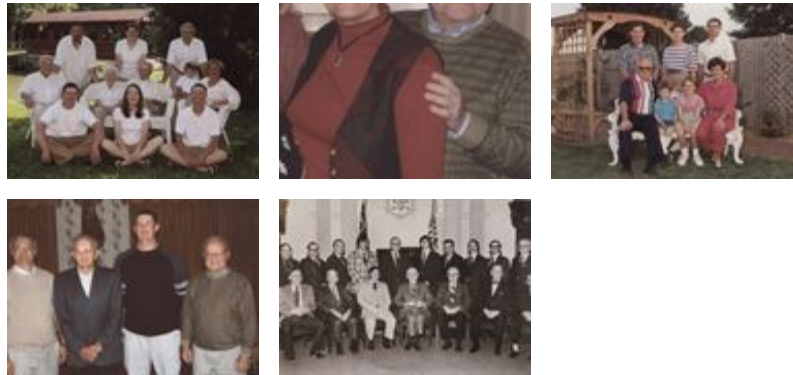

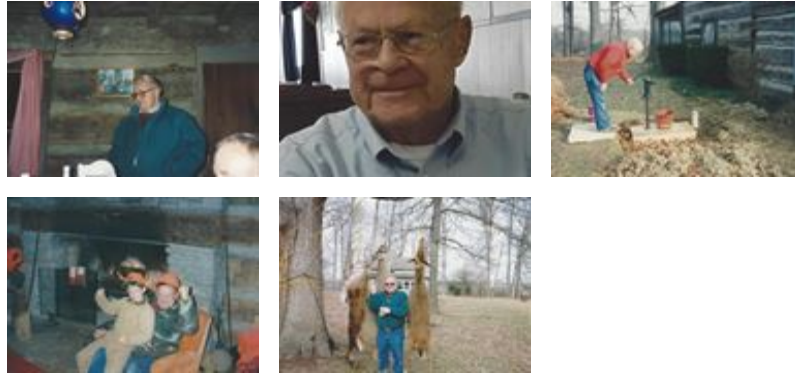
