I would like to give my sincere condolences to all of Dave's family and a little history of my friendship in the army with Dave and over the years.

I first met Dave on the very first day when we both arrived to our duty station at Pioneer Kaserne in Hanau Germany. We both were cooks who were assigned to the same room.

He later told me when he first saw me that because I was so skinny and dressed in a uniform that was so baggy on me that he thought to himself oh how did I wind up with in the same room with this goofy looking guy. It wasn't long after that when we both got to know each other we created a bond and became friends throughout the entire 18 months we were there. We also kept that friendship going for over 50 years despite the long distance we lived from each other.

We spent many days hanging out together in downtown Hanau and sometimes taking a train in to Frankfurt to do some sight seeing. I consider myself fortunate to have had Dave as my roommate, co-worker and friend during my days in Germany. When I first arrived there I was a little depressed because I had been drafted and really didn't want to be in the army or Germany either, but hanging out with Dave on our off hours helped lift up my spirits. He was a fun guy to be with.

I also visited Dave in upper Sandusky 3 different times after we left the army. Each time was something I will always remember. I got to meet his wife and kids the second time and also took nice day trip to

Lake Erie. The last time I was there to visit was quite an experience when Dave let me drive his tractor. Not ever had worked on a farm I thought it was so cool. Here I was driving his tractor through the corn fields singing the theme song to the old TV show Green Acres.
