Donald M. Miller, age 74 of Findlay died on Friday March 30, 2012 at 6:25 p.m. in the Advanced Specialty Hospital of Toledo. He was born Dec. 1, 1937 in Tymochtee Twp. Wyandot County to Chalres E. and Edith M (Yambert) Miller. They both preceded him in death.
