Funeral services for Donald W. Weaver, 83, of 15231 Ohio 67, Forest, will be held at 1:30 p.m. Saturday at Marseilles United Methodist Church, the Rev. Kevin Pees officiating. Burial will be in Tymochtee Cemetery, Upper Sandusky.

Visitation will be held from 2-9 p.m. today and one hour prior to services Saturday at the church.

Mr. Weaver died at 6 p.m. Wednesday, March 17, 1999, at his residence.

He was born Nov. 26, 1915, in Wyandot County to Harry R. and Clara I. (Norris) Weaver. He married Ruthella Fernbaugh on June 2, 1937, and she survives.

He was a member of the Wyandot County Farm Bureau and formerly served on the bureau's Council No. 10 SW, was a 4-H advisor for 30 years for the Marseilles Livewires, was a past Community Club president, and was a charter member of the Marseilles Fire Department.
