Doris M. (Arnold) Cunningham, age 84, formerly of Forest, Butler, East Liverpool, Mansfield and Aurora, Ohio died Wed. Sept. 29, 2010 at 4:50 a.m. in the Hillcrest Hospital, Mayfield Heights.

Doris was born July 1, 1926 in Forest to the late Russell and Nellie (Passet) Forney. She married Robert Arnold on August 6, 1948. He preceded her in death on December 26, 1979. She then married John Cunningham on July 12, 1986. He preceded her in death on February 22, 2005. Doris is the mother of sons Tim W. (Elizabeth) Arnold, Upper Arlington and Thomas E. She directed choirs, bands and orchestras, sang solos and in choruses, played piano and gave piano and voice lessons all of her life.

Mrs. Cunningham was an active member of First Presbyterian Church, Mansfield, and a former member of Trinity Presbyterian Church, East Liverpool.
