



Dorothy L. Snider

January 24, 1926 - June 15, 2013

Dorothy L. "Dot" Snider, age 87 of Forest died Sat June 15, 2013 at Kenton Nursing & Rehabilitation Center. She was born Jan 24, 1926 in Carey to the late Harry & Juanita (Waxler) Green. She married Lee J. Snider on Sept 6, 1947 and he died May 25, 1999.

Mrs. Snider is survived by a daughter Rebecca L. Snider of Forest, a granddaughter Bobbi (Chris) Watts of Gulfport, MS, a great granddaughter Becca L. Watts, 2 sisters Mary Humphrey of Upper Sandusky, Jane Marshall of Shawnee, KS, 3 brothers Max (Mary) Green of Huntsville, Bill (Margo) Green of Swartz Creek, MI, Jerry (Marilyn) Green of Coshocton. She was preceded in death by 3 sisters Betty Lou Green, Beulah McKee, Pat Petryka and 3 brothers Robert, Paul, and Harry Green Jr.

She graduated from Forest High School in 1944. She was a member of the Forest First Presbyterian Church where she was an Elder, Clerk of the Session, and taught Sunday School. She retired from Rahn Sousley Insurance Agency in 1988. Mrs Snider was a 65 year member of the American Legion Aux, Forest Red Hat Society, Hardin Co Democratic Executive Committee, and she worked the election polls. She was a life member of the VFW Ladies Aux, Beta Sigma Phi Sorority and Destroyer Escort Assoc. Mrs. Snider was a former member of the Forest PTA where she served as Pres, Virginia Rebekah Lodge where she served as secretary,

Pythian Sisters, Forest BPW where she served as Pres, Moose Lodge, 8 & 40 Club. She served on the Forest Festival kitchen committee with Lois Jury and Frances Cramer, and the three of them received the first Forest Community Spirit Award. She and her husband were the Grand Marshals in the Forest Festival Parade in 1994. Mrs Snider loved quilting, playing cards, and she was always willing to help others in any way she could.

A funeral service will be held at 10:30AM Thurs June 20, 2013 in the CLARK SHIELDS Funeral Home with Pastor Rex Roth officiating. Interment will follow in Hueston Cemetery, Forest. 
