Edward J. Welker age 66 of Upper Sandusky died at the Ohio State University Medical Center, Columbus at 3:08 p.m. on Monday July 26, 2010. He was born Aug. 14, 1943 in Bucyrus to Ross and Wilma (Edwards) Welker. They are both deceased.

He married Linda Rodgers on March 2, 1968 in the First Lutheran Church and she survives in Upper Sandusky. Also surviving are his daughters Lisa Welker and Kristin Welker both of Upper Sandusky, grandson Logan Cantiberry, Upper Sandusky, brother Samuel Welker, Carey, sister Marianne (Jerry) Higley, Findlay, and many nieces and nephews.
