Eleanor Jane Zimmerman, age 79, of Upper Sandusky died at Wyandot County Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center on Saturday March 28, 2015 at 8:15pm. She was born on October 11, 1935 in Upper Sandusky to the late George Lewis and Hilda Jane (Courtad) Hetzel. Eleanor married Jon C. Zimmerman at St. Paul Lutheran Church on September 16, 1956. He survives in Upper Sandusky.

County Board of Elections as a poll worker. For hobbies she enjoyed riding motorcycles, crafts, reading and collecting books. Eleanor and her family treasured the times spent at Lake Erie boating and fishing. She was a loving and devoted wife, mother and grandmother and will be missed.
