Funeral services for Elizabeth M. Burnett, 91, a resident of the Karrington of Findlay, and formerly of Forest, will be held 11 a.m. Monday at Shields Funeral Home, the Rev. Joe Searfoss officiating. Burial will be in Hueston Cemetery.

Visitation will be held 2-7 p.m. Sunday at the funeral home, where the family will be present from 2-5 p.m.

Mrs. Burnett died at 10:30 a.m. Thursday, Nov. 26, 1998.

She was born Aug. 26, 1907, in Hancock County to Otis E. and Pearl A. (Jackson) Moorhead. She married Clifford M. Burnett on June 21, 1941, and he died July 11, 1996.

Surviving are a son, Joseph M. of Wapakoneta; two daughters, Donna L. Roberts, Zanesville, Mrs. Ron (Martha) Dills, Findlay; a brother, Max of Findlay; a sister Mrs. Hiram (Helen) Abeggan, Worthington; and eight grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by a brother, John; and a sister, Ruth Adams.

Mrs. Burnett was a retired math teacher, having taught at Liberty-Benton,

Forest, Salem and Upper Sandusky schools. She graduated in 1925 from Liberty-Benton School, in 1929 from Findlay College, and earned her master's degree from the University of Michigan.

She was a member of the Forest United Methodist Church and United Methodist Women, a member of the former Rebekah Lodge No. 363 and the Forest Mother's Club Support League, both of Forest, and various other civic and social organizations.
