Eugene W. Frey age 83 of Upper Sandusky, passed away at his residence on February 9, 2023. He was born on August 15, 1939 in Wyandot County to the late Albert and Viola (Kelbley) Frey. Eugene married Jean Ann Frisch on September 12, 1959, and she survives in Upper Sandusky.
