Franklin D. Fulk, 65, of 329 E. Sandusky St., Wharton, OH died at his residence, where he has lived for the passed 40 years, at 10:50AM on Sunday December 23, 2007. He was born on April 6, 1942 in Bucyrus, OH to the late Vernon R. Fulk and Glennice A. Ealy.

Mr. Fulk was a member of the Beechgrove Wesleyan Church where he was a Sunday School Superintendent and a Sunday School Teacher, on the Board of Trustees, a Song Leader and a member of the Choir. He was a 1960 graduate of the former Wharton High School. He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy from 1960-1964 serving as a yeoman on the USS Cimarron. He participated with area veterans marching in local parades. Mr. Fulk was the Master of Ceremony at the Wharton Community Festival for a number of years.
