Franklin D. Hemmerly, age 77 of Upper Sandusky died at 11:10 a.m. on Wed. July 18, 2012 in the Fairhaven Health Care Community. He was born July 14, 1935 in Jackson Twp. to Orville Gerald and Martha Marie Gwinner - Schoenberger Hemmerly.

In 1953 Mr. Hemmerly graduated from Forest High School and was a United States Army Veteran. Mr. Hemmerly had been employed by the former Daybrook Hydraulics, Upper Sandusky, the former John Deere Implement Store of Forest, the former Thompson Vending that later became A. VanBrackle & Sons, both of Forest. He also helped farm with Noble and Jeff Fox.

Mr. Hemmerly was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church where he served as a trustee on church council. He was a member of American Legion Post #225 where he was a bartender.
