Friel E. Ulrich, age 93 formerly of CH 58 Upper Sandusky, OH died at 6:10 p.m. Sat. Aug. 25, 2007 in the Fairhaven Health Care Community.

Mr. Ulrich will be remembered for his saw shaped walking cane, competing in corn husking competitions and playing dartball on the church league. He loved nature and God's creations, traveling, woodworking and especially Christmas when the family came home.
