



George Allen Walton

August 18, 1927 - January 3, 2018

George Allen Walton died at Fairhaven Community on Wed. Jan. 3, 2018. He was 90 years old. Born in Upper Sandusky on Aug. 18, 1927 he was the son of Frederick Hensel Walton and Mary Alice (Sullivan) Walton of Upper Sandusky, Ohio and grandson of Dr. Allen Lincoln Walton of Upper Sandusky, who all preceded him in death. His brother, James F. Walton also preceded him in death.

Mr. Walton graduated from Upper Sandusky High School in 1945. After high school, he served his country in the U.S. Navy during World War II from 1945-1946. He graduated from Bowling Green State University in 1950. He was

recalled in the Navy from 1950-1952. He was a retired Industrial Arts and Social Studies Teacher. He retired from Mohawk High School in 1982. He returned to Upper Sandusky, Ohio in 2003 after living 18 years in Florida. He was a member of John Stewart United Methodist Church, Upper Sandusky, OH, B.P.O.E., American Legion No. 225, and a life member of the D.A.V. and V.F.W.

Mr. Walton loved to talk to people. No one was a stranger to him. He loved to dance, play cards, do jigsaw puzzles and woodworking projects. He also loved to get together with family.

A private family service will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 11, 2018 at Bringman Clark Funeral Home, Upper Sandusky, with the Pastor Doug Pummell officiating. Visitation will be one hour before the private family service. Burial will be at Oak Hill Cemetery, with military rites.
