June 13, 1928 - January 18, 2013

Glen M. McDaniel, age 84 of Forest died on Friday Jan. 18, 2013 at 12:30 p.m. in the woods close to his residence while cutting firewood. He was born on June 13, 1928 in Jackson Twp. Wyandot Co. to Russell and Mary (Wentz) McDaniel. Glen married Mary Ruth Vogt on July 3, 1951 and she survives in Forest.

Mr. McDaniel is survived by a son Donald (Karen) McDaniel, Forest, daughters Beth (Steve) Monnette, Marion, Linda (Zachary) Neds, Boston; MA, four grandchildren Ryan McDaniel, Ryan (Sarah) Rodabaugh, Allison and Andrew Neds, sisters Evelyn Price, Upper Sandusky, Janet McCann, Mayer; AZ, Carol (Charles) Wright, Forest, brothers Eugene (Alice), Marion, Irvin (Maxine), Marysville, Paul (Lois), Findlay. He was preceded in death by his parents, son Allen Wayne and sister Clela Fry.

He was a retired life long Jackson Twp. grain and livestock farmer. Mr. McDaniel had at one time worked at the Gramm Trailer Company as a welder. Glen was a member of Heritage Christian Union Church where he was active in the building of the church and was a past trustee and former Sunday School Superintend.
