Glenn E. March, 76, of 307 S. Mary St., Forest, died at 12:39 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 25, 2000 at Wyandot Memorial Hospital's emergency room, Upper Sandusky.

He was born Jan. 11, 1924 in Wyandot County to Roy W. and Edith (Williams) March. He married W. Jean Evans on July 26, 1952, and she survives.

Other survivors include a daughter, Mrs. Charles (Merrilee) McClaskey, Marion; a son, Lynn A. of Dublin; three grandchildren; and a sister, Mabel Schoenberger, Upper Sandusky.

He was preceded in death by three sisters, Helen March, Marguerite Wallace and Donna Rish; and two brothers, John and Roy Franklin March.

Mr. March, a 1942 Forest High School graduate, retired as a self-employed Borden Dairy distributor. He also retired as the owner and operator of Forest Variety Store, and had been a Riverdale School bus driver.

He was a member of Forest United Methodist Church. He was a member of Senate Lodge 378 F&AM, Forest, where he was lodge master in 1959. He was a life member of Elks Lodge 157, Kenton. He was past president of Forest and Riverdale athletic boosters; was instrumental in building bleachers

at D. Ray Baum Field at Riverdale; and Riverdale's baseball field was named after him.

He and his wife had served as grand marshals of Forest's Tree Town Festival Parade.

Funeral services will be held at 1 p.m. Saturday at Shields Funeral Home, Forest, the Rev. Douglas Widdowson officiating. Burial will be in Jackson Center Cemetery, Forest.

Visitation will be held from 6-8 p.m. today, and from 2-4 and 6-8 p.m. Friday at the funeral home. Masonic services will be held at 7 p.m. today at the funeral home.
