Rev. Harley F. Duncan age 98 of Upper Sandusky, died at his residence on Wed. July 1, 2020.

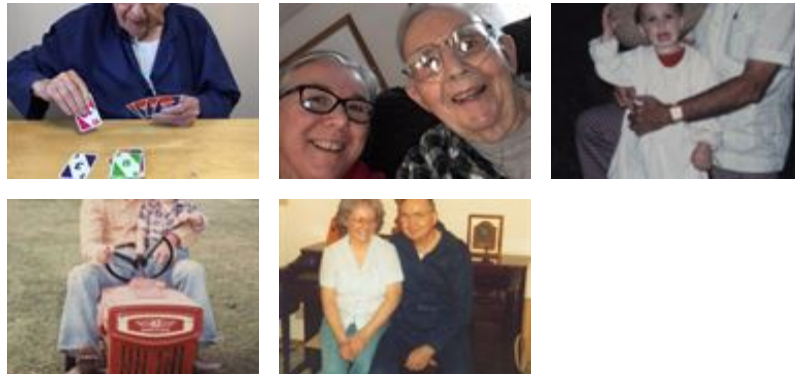
