



## Harold C. Plott

September 25, 1936 - January 9, 2024

Harold Plott passed away peacefully Tuesday morning, January 9, 2024, at Wyandot County Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center after suffering from several falls, breaking his hip, and having 2 surgeries. He was born on September 25, 1936 to Herschel A. and Ella Mae (Gutermuth) Plott in Mifflin Township, Wyandot County. Harold married Marilyn (Karg) Plott on October 28, 1960, and shared 63 years of marriage together.

Harold is survived by his wife, Marilyn and his 3 daughters Renae (Kevin) Clements, Janine Gilliland (JJ Rall), and Rhonda Plott-Frost (Andy Gile), and 3 grandchildren, Caleb (Sarah) Harris, Upper Sandusky, Jarrod Gilliland (Rene Heffelfinger), Dublin, and Megan Frost (Mason Clouse), Dublin, and 1 great grandson, Cooper Jameson Harris. He is also survived by his sister Vera Stansbery, rural Upper Sandusky, and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, 2 brothers A. Eugene Plott and Allen Plott, and sister-in-law Nancy Plott, brother-in-law Vernon Stansbery, and niece Charlotte Stoneburner.

He joined 6 year Army reserve in 1957 and trained at Fort Knox, KT and then trained for 6 months at Fort Gordon, GA. Harold was a lifetime member, 64 years, of the Elks, and was also a member of the American Legion and the Moose Lodge. He was of the Lutheran faith and a member of the St. Paul Lutheran Church.

Harold was a graduate of Upper Sandusky High School, graduating in 1954. After graduation he worked at Grundtisch Motor Sales, then worked at Whirlpool Corp. in Marion starting in 1966 for 34 years as a painter before retiring in 2000. During this time he also worked part time at Wyandot Tractor and Implement. After retirement, he enjoyed going to McDonald's for morning coffee with his friends. Even after retirement, he was always busy helping friends and family doing mechanic work. He spend many Sunday's at Grafmiller's Sohio Station helping pump gas and do mechanic work whenever needed.

A private family burial will take place at Old Mission Cemetery. A celebration of life will be held at a later date.
