



## Helen F Quail

January 21, 1921 - February 28, 2018

Helen F. Quail died on Wednesday, February 28, 2018 at St. Ann's Hospital in Westerville at the age of 97 after suddenly taking ill.

Helen was born on January 21st 1921 to Myron and Bernice Forney. She grew up on the family farm near Forest. She graduated from Forest High School where she played the trombone and was captain of the girl's basketball team. Helen went on to earn a degree at Bliss Business College and worked most of her professional life at the Ohio Council of Retail Merchants.

She was a lifelong member of Big Oak Methodist Church, where she married John Paul Quail of Forest in 1945. They lived in Mansfield for a short time then moved to Columbus where they remained. They enjoyed family, friends, traveling, and boating and fishing on Lake Erie.
