### WW II US ARMY VETERAN:

Herman "Ducky" Edgington 89 of Patterson, passed away Saturday January 19th at 12:50 at Riverside Methodist Hospital in Columbus, Ohio. He was born at home in Patterson on December 21, 1918 to Arthur and Lily Edgington. He graduated from Forest High School in 1936 where he excelled in Football and Baseball. Herman was drafted in the Army during WWII where he was a member of the 82nd Airborne Div. Echo Company. He was awarded the Purple Heart during his service and returned home after the war to help with the family farm. He married his sweetheart, Marjorie M. McEvoy (Wharton) on April 4th 1947 and they shared 60 plus years together before his passing. They have one child, Roger L Edgington of Medina, Ohio. A daughter-in-law Jane (nee: Opperman of Findlay), a granddaughter, Suzie Forte (of Wooster) and two beautiful great-granddaughters, Melanie and Katie. He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother Clarence.
