



Ira R. "Willie" Wilson Jr.

Ira R. "Willie" Wilson Jr. age 71 formerly of Galion and more recently of Marblehead, died at St. Rita's Hospital, Lima on Tuesday Dec. 26, 2017 at 10:34pm. He was born on October 2, 1946 in Richlands, VA, to the late Ira R. Wilson Sr. and Louise (Brown) Simmons of Arkansas.

He married Patricia "Pat" Mills on Feb. 14, 1985 and she survives in Marblehead.
