### WWII NAVY VETERAN

Graveside services for Jack A. Jones, 80, a resident of Baldwin Manor, Kenton, and formerly of Forest, will be held at 2 p.m. Friday at Hale Cemetery, Mount Victory, the Rev. Mark Bishop officiating. Military rites will be conducted by McVitty VFW Post 1182 and American Legion Post 259, both of Forest.

Visitation will be private.

Mr. Jones died at 8:50 a.m. Sunday, Aug. 19, 2001, at his residence.

He was born Dec. 3, 1920, in Mount Victory to Fay and Grace (James) Jones. He married Doris E. Powell on May 7, 1944, and she survives.

Also surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Richard (Connie) Curl, rural Forest; and two grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Zellon.

Mr. Jones retired as a guard from Marion Correctional Institute, and had also retired from Huber Corp. in Marion.

He was a U.S. Navy veteran of World War II, serving as an electricians mate.
