He also was on the Hancock-Wood Electric Board of Directors for 22 years and on the State REA Board of Directors for 20 years. He was a former member of the Hancock Co. Regional Planning Commission, a former member of the Board of Directors of Landmark, former president Wharton Local Schools PTA, and a former Wharton Livestock 4-H leader. Mr. Rose was

also a life member of the former Union Chapel Church, Forest. John was an avid sports fan especially the Ohio State Buckeyes.
