



## Jon C. Zimmerman

Jon C. Zimmerman, 89, of Upper Sandusky, passed away on November 25, 2025, in Findlay under the compassionate care of Bridge Hospice. He was born on April 1, 1936, in Upper Sandusky to Carl and Madeline (Rowe) Zimmerman. Jon graduated from Upper Sandusky High School and went on to attend Michigan State University, where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Horticulture.

Jon married Eleanor (Hetzl) who preceded him in death. Together, they owned and operated Zimmerman Flower Shop, where Jon took great pride in serving his customers and friends, always with the help and support of his beloved wife. Jon was an active member of St. Paul Lutheran Church and later First Lutheran Church. 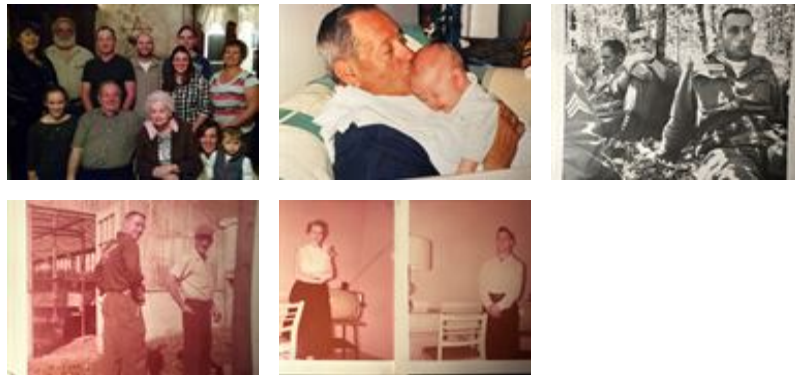
