March 2, 1912 - August 9, 2015

Joseph L. Kern of Upper Sandusky died at Fairhaven Community on Sunday August 9, 2015 at 4:40pm at the age of 103.

He was born March 2, 1912 in Reading, PA being the eldest son of Richard F. and Lucille S. (Harple) Kern. He married Elsie Montgomery on Oct. 14, 1939 at Bethel Methodist Church, Spring City, PA and they enjoyed 69 years of marriage before her passing on July 09, 2009.

Joe was preceded in death by four sisters Catherine, Dorothy, Lillian and Lucille and four brothers Leon, Jessie, Dick and Sonny Joseph. He is survived by nieces and nephews and a special cousin Sally (Sherman) Stansbery who cared for him.

Mr. Kern was a 1930 graduate of Phoenixville High School, going on to West Chester State Teachers College and graduate school at Temple University all in PA. For four years, he was a teacher at Phoenixville Junior High school and for 21 years he was a teacher and counselor in the Junior and Senior High Schools of West Chester, PA. Joe was a caring and loving teacher always helping those who needed it.

He was active member of Trinity Evangelical United Methodist Church in Upper Sandusky for the past 26 years where he sang in the church choir

rendering many solos. Joe was also a member of Bethel United Methodist Church for over 40 years in Spring City, PA where he served many years as a Sunday school teacher and choir member. Mr. Kern received an honorable discharge from the military service in 1943. Joe held life memberships in the Chester County Council of Parent-Teacher Associations, National Education Association and the West Chester State College Alumni. In his younger years Joe enjoyed traveling and living in Arizona. After his retirement he won several state shuffle board tournaments. He also excelled in growing beautiful roses which he shared with friends and nursing home residence.

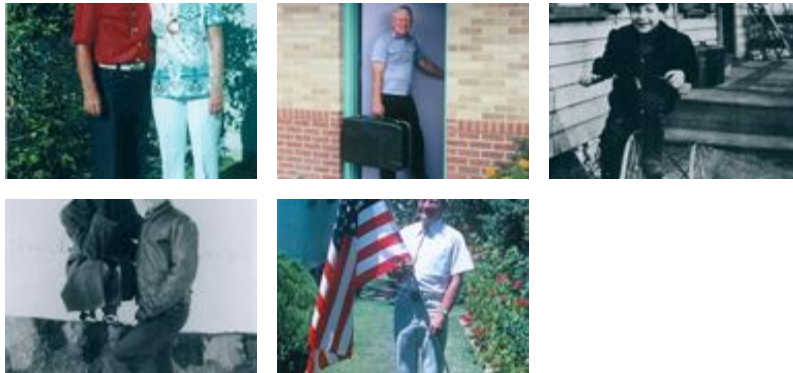
