Kenneth D. Phillips age 85, of Upper Sandusky died at The Ohio State University Hospital on Wed. Jan. 18, 2017. 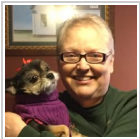

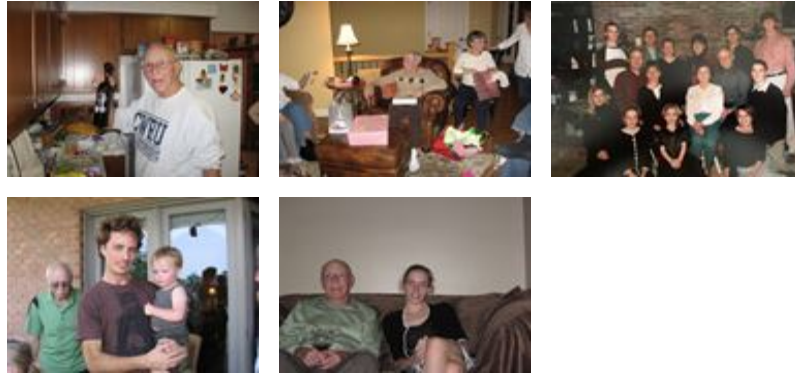

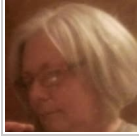
