Leah Jean Wolfe age 100 of Upper Sandusky, died at Wyandot County Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center on Saturday May 16, 2020 at 7:05pm. She was born on July 20, 1919 in Upper Sandusky to Arthur and Rae (Case) Walton.
