WW II US NAVY VETERAN

Lee Jay Snider, 74, of 512 S. Patterson St., Forest, died at 4:15 a.m. Tuesday, May 25, 1999, at Baldwin Manor, Kenton.

He was born Jan. 1, 1925, in Hardin County to Elmer E. and A. Marie (Spencer) Snider. He married Dorothy L. Green on Sept. 6, 1947, and she survives.

Also surviving are one daughter, Rebecca L. Tracy, Forest; one grandchild; one great-grandchild; two brothers, Robert E. of Forest; Loren E. of Tiffin; and two sisters, Mrs. James (Dolly) Rodman, Forest; Mrs. Rick (Pat) Morrison, Marion.

He was preceded in death by two brothers, Burton and Donald.

Mr. Snider retired as a mail carrier for the U.S. Postal Service after 43 years.

He was a member of First Presbyterian Church, Forest, where he served as an elder and deacon. During World War II, he served in the U.S. Navy as a radioman. He was a member of Elks Lodge 157, Kenton, and Forest Lions

Club, where he was treasurer for many years and received the Melvin Jones Award. He also was a member and past commander of American Legion Post 259, Forest. He was a life member of McVitty VFW Post 1182, Forest, member of the former IOOF Lodge 394, Forest, and member of Destroyer Escort Association.

Mr. Snider graduated from Forest High School in 1942. He was a former umpire for the Forest Softball Association.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Friday at Shields Funeral Home, Forest, the Rev. Rex Roth officiating. Burial will be in Hueston Cemetery, Forest, where military rites will be conducted by McVitty VFW Post 1182 and American Legion Post 259, both of Forest.
