



Lee W Kellogg

March 1, 1926 - December 23, 2015

Lee W. Kellogg, age 89 of Forest, died at Blanchard Place, Kenton on Wednesday December 23, 2015 at 1:05pm. He was born on March 1, 1926 in Forest to Ralph W. and Olive G. (Keller) Kellogg. He married R. Louise Brown on July 23, 1948 and she preceded him in death on February 2, 1980. Lee then married Patricia Mewhorter and she preceded him in death.

Mr. Kellogg is survived by two daughters Teresa Parsell, Redding, CA, Cheryl Kellogg, Forest, son William Kellogg, Forest, four step children Steve Mewhorter, Mike Mewhorter, Mark Mewhorter and Sharon (Dana) Price, 9 grandchildren, 13 great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by a daughter Anna Burke.

Mr. Kellogg graduated from Forest high school in 1944. He was a staff sergeant in the US Army serving in the infantry during WW II. He fought in the Battle of the Bulge. Lee was a member of Forest United Methodist Church.

Mr. Kellogg was a grain and livestock farmer in Jackson Twp. Hardin County. He worked for ODOT for 30 years and served on the School board for 36 years, 20 of those years where with Hardin County Educational Services Center Board and 16 was with the Riverdale School Board. Lee was a life member of the McVitty VFW Post #1182, Forest. He was also a member of the American Legion #259, Forest, Masonic Lodge

#378, Forest, Aladine Shrine, Columbus, Hardin County Shriner. Lee enjoyed being an avid Buckeye fan.

A funeral service will be held on Monday December 28, 2015 at 10:30am in Clark Shields Funeral Home with Pastor Denny Livingston officiating. Burial will follow in Patterson Cemetery with full Military Honors conducted by McVitty VFW Post #1182, American Legion Post #259 both of Forest and AmVets Post #1994, Kenton. 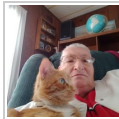
