



## Loumier Vacla Kolarik

September 23, 1921 - November 2, 2014

Loumier "Lou" Vacla Kolarik, age 93 of Arlington went to be with his Lord and Savior on Sun Nov 2, 2014. He was born Sept 23, 1921 in Zanesville to the late Wesley Joseph & Ethel Marie (Handley) Kolarik. He married Alma F. (Karcher) McClain on Dec 15, 1945 and she died July 2, 2005.
