Funeral services for Lowell A. McNutt, 76, of 12669 Township Road 84, Forest, will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday at Shields Funeral Home, Forest, the Rev. Steve Umphress officiating. Burial will be in Hueston Cemetery, Forest, with military rites by McVitty VFW Post 1182 and American Legion Post 259, both in Forest.

Mr. McNutt died at 9:35 p.m. Tuesday, Dec. 17, 2002 at Fostoria Community Hospital.

He was born Aug. 6, 1926 in Wyandot County to Allen and Blanche M. (Clinger) McNutt. He married Dorothy E. Hougendobler on March 28, 1948, and she died April 2, 1991. He then married Betty Chadwick on April 11, 1992, and she died Dec. 22, 2000.
