Lucille A. Wanamaker, Upper Sandusky, died on Monday, April 12, 2010 at 10:40 p.m. in the Marion General Hospital. She was 104.

Born in Putnam County, OH on April 26, 1905 she was the daughter of George and Amelia (Shumaker) Webken. She married Norbert Wanamaker on Oct. 11, 1931. He died on May 29, 1965.

She is survived by a son John (Linda) Wanamaker, West Bloomfield, MI and a daughter Norma Wanamaker, Upper Sandusky. She is preceded in death by a daughter Marilyn Wanamaker and an infant son Joseph. Also preceding her in death were sisters Mary Webken German, Sister Barbara CPPS, Sister Alexine CPPS, Ida Webken Kilgore and a brother Joseph Webken.

A graduate of the College of Mount St. Joseph, Cincinnati, OH, she was an elementary teacher in the Upper Sandusky Schools and at St. Peters School. Prior to that she taught in Cleveland, Fort Jennings and Fremont Schools.

She was a member of the Transfiguration of the Lord Catholic Church and its Prayer Support Ministry. She was also a member of the Catholic Ladies of Columbia.

Mrs. Wanamaker was member of the Wyandot County Retired Teachers Assn. and the Ohio Retired Teachers Assn. After retirement she was a volunteer at

Angeline School.
