M. Jane Hehr, age 93 of Cavanaugh Ct., Upper Sandusky died at Fairhaven Community on Tuesday Feb. 10, 2015 at 2:20pm. She was born July 2, 1921 in Upper Sandusky to Mervin Myers and Helen (Secoy) Myers. She married Charles E. Hehr on January 28, 1939 and they shared 76 years of marriage.
