Marian M. Stephan of Upper Sandusky, OH died at home with her family present at 9:45AM on March 12, 2011. She was born to Page Cromley Morris and Mary Elizabeth (Walsh) Morris on July 15, 1911, in Nelsonville, OH. She was 99 years of age at the time of her decease.

Mrs. Stephan graduated from Nelsonville High School in 1928 and Summa Cum Laude from Ohio University in Athens, OH in 1932. While at Ohio University, she was a member of Pi Beta Phi, Sigma Alpha Iota, Cresset Chapter of Motor Board, Kappa Delta Pi, and Phi Beta Kappa.

On June 12, 1937, Marian married Paul S. Stephan, who preceded her in death on Sept. 15, 1998.
